## INCIDENT DISCLOSURE

- Incident disclosure is the process for which a critical incident or patient safety event is communicated to the patient, their care partner, or substitute decision maker
- Disclosure is a process a dialogue over time
- It typically includes an expression of sympathy or regret
- It helps maintain a positive relationship between the healthcare provider and the patient
- WCH provides support and guidance for staff and physicians about the disclosure process, including the Incident Disclosure policy document available on www.mywch.ca

Incident disclosure promotes open communication and a supportive response.
